

How to find us

Ignetica Ltd is based at the Blakemere Centre in Sandiway, Cheshire. This former Edwardian Hall and stable block dates back to 1890 and was often visited by King Edward VII, then the Prince of Wales. Unfortunately Blakemere Hall was demolished in 1950 and just the historic stables remain. The site has been extensively developed now comprising offices, boutique shops and craft centre.

Directions:

By Air: We are approximately 30 minutes from Manchester Airport and 30 minutes from Liverpool (John Lennon) airport.

By Train: Hartford station is on the West Coast main line and is approximately 5 minutes away by car. Alternatively Crewe Station is 35 minutes.

By Car: We are approximately 15 minutes from the M6 and 10 minutes from the M56.

From the **M6 North** exit at junction 18, taking the A54 to Middlewhich, the A530 to Northwich and then the A556 towards Chester.

From the **M6 South** take junction 19 and follow the A556 towards Chester.

From the **M56** take Junction 10 and head south on the A49.

The Blakemere Centre is easy to find close to the intersection of the A49 and A556. The site entrance is easy to identify with large signs and local information signs to "Blakemere Craft Centre".

After parking follow the onsite signs to unit 19 in the main courtyard.
